PURPOSE The Texas Onsite Wastewater Association Scholarship Fund was established in 2017. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals that are dependents of TOWA members and plan to continue their education attending a Community College, four-year college, University or Trade School.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in environmental programs including but not limited to volunteer hours. Scholarships are awarded annually provided funds are available.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Texas Onsite Wastewater Association awards scholarships based on a comprehensive process. Areas that are reviewed by the committee include but are not limited to the following: Academic Accomplishments, Community Service, References, Essay and Financial Need. The Association pays scholarship funds directly to the recipient or to the university of choice as instructed by the recipient. Scholarships are awarded annually. The Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender, or sexual orientation. Scholarships awarded are based upon the availability of funds and additional qualifying criteria.

CRITERIA

Applicants must be completing or have completed high school successfully with a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale or already be attending a higher education institution.

CRITERIA Continued

Applicants must be accepted as a full-time student at a college or university for the upcoming academic semester. If scholarship money is awarded, this is the only program that will receive the funds on behalf of the applicant.

Applicants must be a citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States. Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application by **May 30**.

TIMELINE

Applications are due **May 30 of the current calendar year**.

Candidates may be asked for an interview by the Scholarship Committee conducted in early April. Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by June 30.

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official proof of academic standing.
- 500 word or more essay on the importance of water/wastewater today.
- A letter of academic reference from a guidance counselor, teacher, or principal.
- A letter of reference from an employer or other community member.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic school for post-secondary studies.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Awards will be given by the end of June, provided all paperwork has been received by the committee.

Applicant must provide their **student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be used**.

Award amounts will be distributed bi-annually after all requirements are met.
